LEARN: CARE FOR OUR COAST EDUCATIONAL UNIT

Before you start the ‘Clean up our Coast’ programme your school might want to participate in the ‘Care for our Coast’ educational unit.

FOR PRIMARY AND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOLS	FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS
<p>This resource targets Years 4-8 and is designed to take 4 to 8 weeks to complete.</p> <p>It covers achievement objectives from the Science and Social Science portions of the curriculum (Levels 2 to 4). However, each section of the resource includes cross-curricular links.</p> <p>The resource contains nine units on Caring for our Coast. These centre on coastal processes and various environmental issues that affect our marine environment. Students are encouraged to learn about the issues using a range of stimulating group and individual activities.</p> <p>It also includes the Sir Peter Blake Learning Centre where students are able to learn about Sir Peter and the importance of his environmental work</p> <p>The resource contains useful links for teachers and each unit has its own learning intentions and success criteria.</p>	<p>This resource targets Years 9 & 10 and is designed to take 4 to 6 weeks to complete.</p> <p>It covers achievement objectives from the Science and Social Science portions of the curriculum (Levels 4 to 6).</p> <p>The resource begins with students learning about the marine environment and the food chains that occur in this unique ecosystem. The rest of the resource then looks at the way in which these organisms and their environment are impacted by urban and rural activity.</p> <p>As in the primary school resource students have the opportunity to learn about Sir Peter Blake and the conservation message he advocated during his lifetime.</p> <p>Each unit incorporates learning objectives, extensive teacher’s notes and action points so that students become aware of their role in reducing marine pollution.</p>

- * On the Care for our Coast homepage, click on the 'Results + Data Entry' and 'Enter Your Own Results'.
- * A spreadsheet will open up in a similar format as your clean up form. You simply enter your findings in the form and click 'Submit'.
- * You will then receive your summarised results in the form of pie graphs and bar graphs. This will enable you to see how your results compare with the nationwide clean-up data. Don't forget to bookmark the web-page onto your own computer to refer to later.
- * Please also remember to post, fax or email your completed survey to the Sir Peter Blake Trust, who will validate your data to be included as part of the nationwide clean-ups, and send out a certificate.
